The Century Home Plaque Application fee is \$150, for which you will receive a 12"x16" plaque inscribed with the name of the original owner(s) and the date the home was built. It is necessary that you obtain a membership in the Webster Groves Historical Society so that you have access to our home research tools and have Society guidance with your application. In such instances, this may require a judgment call as to the names to be identified on the plaque. Please include all pertinent names that you discover.
